NPP / Ali Doyle Meeting

- Mike, Talia, and Gordon met with Ali Doyle of State Economic Development and were joined by Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy.
- Representatives of the MWCDC provided the State with a general update on the organization's transition and introduced the new Executive Director
- Ali encouraged the MWCDC to apply for another round of the NPP grant.
 Recommended tailoring the application to the strategic plan and the park master plan
- The Executive Director and the Board will start the process of preparing a new application for the NPP grant and will reevaluate the corporate sponsor relationship

4. Executive Directors Report

Status/Updates

- Greg is developing banners and signage
- Wrote Business Expo after action report. Will put it on the MWCDC shared drive and share with Board
- Master Lease is signed. Means that MWCDC will reimbursed on timely basis
- Gordon's mom is creating a database of MWCDC discs. He has a volunteer helping with website management

- Terry mentioned a wayfinding plan with parks. Gordon is looking for a signage plan for the community.
- Scanning function of the printer has broken, but Gordon fixed it. Can send board members scanned documents

New Projects/Initiatives

- Drafting policies and procedures manual and employee handbook revisions
- Gordon is reviewing the MWCDC Bylaws. He will be proposing amendments to the Bylawa to the Board. Some of the issues he has found are as follows:
 - Consensus decision-making process needs to be formalized.
 - Recommending changes to the number of board members
 - Is putting together other recommendations that he will present to all board members and will include justification and timeline for changes
 - Board and Gordon will review and edit drafts. Draft recommendations will be presented to community at a Community Forum
- After Action plan for Business Expo highlight opportunities and needs with relationship/communication to business community
 - Need for a physical bulletin board
 - Gordon is reviewing old marketing plans to find items that could be used by the MWCDC
- Gordon now doing eblasts and social media posts.
 - Board should pass along content and ideas to Gordon

5. Corporate Resolution Removal

- Laura Guralnick, the previous interim executive director, needs to be removed from old Corporate Resolutions

 - Met with a consultant to review marketing and plan. The Consultant donated her time.
 - She suggested outreach to former partners to reengage for a smaller donation ask
 - Committee will draft a letter
 - Chris got a \$5,000 sponsorship to cover beer

- Developing a fundraising night/event for the Curb Appeal program
- o Senko Construction presented a timeframe for their construction project
- Committee reviewed Shiloh street signage

• Emerald View Park - Terry

- Attended awards ceremony for the Frick Environmental Center's Green Building Challenge
- Attended Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy's Development Committee
 - Empty space and underdevelopment spaces as they pertain to stormwater
 - Suspects there may be grant funding for these types of projects, will investigate further
 - Free street trees through the Shade Tree Commission
 - Trees will be dug and planted for free
 - Terry will compile information and work to recruit applicants
 - There is a new Park Ranger in the park. Helps provide information to park goers, not focused on enforcement

• Advocacy Committee – Talia

- Talia and Alaina presented the Advocacy Committee to the community at last months community forum
- Next meeting is scheduled June 27th at the Senior Center
 - Agenda will be created prior to the meeting
- The "Welcome Center" project could be the first campaign of the committee
- Alaina and Talia want ideas for projects to organically rise out of the committee
- Talia asked for recommendations for individuals who should be recruited to join/assist the committee
