****** Executive Directors Report July 11, 2024

Food Bank: Awaiting permits to begin construction. \$2250 raised this month. Total raised \$122,000. ED is in touch with the architect and things seem to be proceeding on schedule.

ED met with potential Funders including the Hillman Foundation. Terry Moss is working on the grant. We are hopeful they'll grant \$100,000 and BirminghamFoundation will match with an additional \$50,000.

ED met with GBU who are interested in helping market our Food Bank situation in their network. They also will finance a direct mail campaign in 15211. Hopefully this bears fruit, as grants and other funding take time

Community meeting in June: The Deer program meeting with Park Ranger Marya was very informative, and relatively well attended. Aside from one vocal opponent, it seemed the community is behind the limited bow hunt.

Other Grants: Project Director has applied for all the NPP, NIF, and outdoor dining grants. He has worked with the Parks Conservancy and everything has been submitted on time.
